How to Enable/Disable AutoComplete

Use this document if:


- You want to enable or disable the AutoComplete feature in Microsoft® Internet Explorer 7 (IE7).
 - The AutoComplete feature suggests possible matches for entries you type in the Address toolbar, a Web page form, or user name and password fields on a Web page.

This document assumes:


- You have IE7 installed and are using it.
- You are connected to the Internet.

Enable/Disable AutoComplete

1. Open **Internet Explorer 7**.
2. In the Windows Taskbar, select **Tools**. Then, select **Internet Options**.




3. Select the **Content** tab. In the “AutoComplete” section, select **Settings**.




4. To enable AutoComplete functions, select the appropriate **check boxes**.


When finished, select **OK**.



- To disable AutoComplete, uncheck all of the boxes. Then, select **OK**.



- Once all desired changes are made in the AutoComplete section on the "Content" tab, select **Apply** on the "Internet Options" page. Then, select **OK**.





Using AutoComplete

Suggestions made by AutoComplete are displayed in a list as soon as Internet Explorer recognizes familiar patterns. If a suggestion in the list matches what you want, follow these steps:

1. Select the **suggestion** provided, or use the **down arrow** key to display a list of additional suggestions.
2. Then, select **Enter**.
