- You know your msn.com e-mail address and password.
- Your msn.com e-mail address is associated to a Qwest DSL® account.
- You have a working copy of mail.
- You have a working Internet connection.


Incoming/Outgoing server info: If you are familiar with how to configure your email client, use the following information. If you need more help, continue reading.

- Outgoing Server:
 - smtp.live.com
 - requires authentication:
 - Username: email address
 - Password: email password


1. Open Mail using the icon on your dock.



2. If this is your first time using Mail, you will see a 'Welcome to Mail' screen. Otherwise, select **File** then **Add Account...**



3. This will appear on your outgoing e-mail. (e.g. personal name, nickname or company name)



4. Enter your **e-mail address** and **password**, select **Continue**



9. Select **Continue**.




10. Type **smtp.live.com** in both fields




11. Check **Use Authentication**

- Password: email password







12. Select **Continue**




13. Select **Create**.




14. Select **Mail**, then **Preferences**.
