



Cisco® 675/678 Modem

How to Install the Cisco Commander Software Updates Version 1.4.2

Windows®

1. An automatic search will locate your modem. The search and download will take up to 5 minutes. Continue only when prompted.
2. Type your password, then select **Continue**.
3. Select **Update**. Interrupting the download process could disable your modem.
4. Select **Continue**. The modem will reboot. This could take up to 3 minutes.
5. Select **OK**.
6. Select **Next**.
7. Select **Next**, again.
8. Select **Start 67x Commander** and **Place 67x Commander in Startup folder**.
9. Select **Finish**.
10. Select **CBOS 2.4.6 CAP67x**. Then, select **OK**.
11. Type your password. Select **OK**. If you don't have a password, leave the password field blank and select **OK**.
12. Reconnect the high-speed Internet line to the "wall" port on the back of the modem. Reset any other configuration changes you've made. This includes reinstalling hardware and software firewalls.
13. Double-click on the **Commander** icon in the system tray in the bottom right corner of your screen.
14. If the modem isn't trained, select the **Open Connection** bar. (The modem is trained if the "Connection State" field says "Opened.")
